

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

May 14, 2013

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting, May 6, 2013, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Building and Plan Commission Director Dann Bird said a notice was sent to 332 W. Washington St. primarily concerning the condition of the roof. Dann said the owner has requested an additional 90 days in order to sell the house as is, but he hasn't had a chance to see the inside of the house to see what, if any, water damage has been done resulting from the roof not being repaired. Mr. Williams moved to take this under advisement for a week so Dann can see the interior of the house, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote to take this under advisement.

Under miscellaneous business, for the record, Mayor DeBaun said he has released Kent Cassidy from the mowing contract with the Parks Department. He said officially the Parks Board will do that; however a decision was made in his office to retain Brad McIntire, of McIntire Landscaping to catch up on the unmowed parks.

Mayor DeBaun said there will be a reception tomorrow at the Methodist Building, on the Public Square, to allow the public and members of the Administration and various Boards to meet the new owner, Mitch Genser. Mitch and his group will talk about their plans for the building, with the reception lasting from 4:30 to 7:00 p.m. The event will be hosted by 18 on the Square, Tour of Italy, Daredevil Brewing Co., and Buck Creek Winery.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
