

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 14, 2017

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 14, 2017, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on February 7, 2017, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun said he had a recommendation from Cornerstone, the City's site consultant on the Blue River Trailhead project, to award the bid to Runnebohm Construction. Mr. Finkel moved to accept Cornerstone's recommendation of Runnebohm Construction, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said he had a new SOP, number 73, from the Police Department. Police Chief Mark Weidner said it outlines procedures for using Narcan to counteract the effects of a drug overdose. Mr. Williams moved to approve the new SOP, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Chief Weidner had a letter of resignation from Officer Matt Terkhorn, to become effective February 24. Under discussion, Mr. Williams said he'd like to take a look, when the Chief gets a chance, to see what our percentages are of hiring people from other departments and how long they stay. He said it seems like we're getting a lot of that anymore. Chief Weidner said it seems like everybody's getting a lot of that anymore. Mr. Finkel moved to accept the letter of resignation from Officer Terkhorn, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mayor DeBaun wanted to remind everyone that the City of Shelbyville will be open next Monday, for President's Day, so regular trash will be picked up that day.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
