Regular Meeting

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.


There was no old business.

Jennifer Jones, Street Commissioner, wanted to remind everyone that the recycling program does not start until July 10th and not to use your cans until then.


