

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

July 3, 2017

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, July 3, 2017, at 8:29 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on June 27, 2017, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun had a recommendation from City Engineer Matt House to award the Amos Road storm sewer project to M & C Excavating, at a price of \$90,100.00. Mr. Finkel moved to approve, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote. A portion of Amos Road, from Congressional Way to McKay Road, will be closed from July 5 through July 12 to install the storm sewers.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun opened and read two bids for the Amos Road project, which will go from Loper Drive to Progress Parkway. The following companies, along with their bid amounts, are listed below:

Milestone Contractors LP	\$591,807.70
Dave O'Mara Contractor	\$723,257.00

The engineer's estimate was \$575,000.00. Mayor DeBaun said Matt House would like to look at the bids, so a brief recess was taken. After review from Matt, Mr. Finkel moved to approve Milestone's bid, and Mr. Williams seconded.


It was announced that the Shelby County Fair will start tomorrow.

Mayor DeBaun wanted to give a public thank you to the County Commissioners and the County Highway Department. He's been riding his bike throughout the County and the southwestern area of the County where paving has been completed, and he said it's much nicer riding.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
