

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

July 25, 2017

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, July 25, 2017, at 8:29 A.M. Mr. Williams was absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on July 18, 2017, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun said Robertson Paving had the low bid last week to demolish two homes in Shelbyville. Mr. Finkel moved to approve Robertson's bid of \$24,500.00, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said Main Street Shelbyville has requested permission to close the west half of the Circle on Friday, August 4, at 8:00 A.M., for its First Friday event. The event will last from 5:30 P.M. until 8:30 P.M. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.


