

## COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

January 3, 2018

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, January 3, 2018, at 6:57 P.M. Councilwoman Bowen opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, and Councilman Carmony followed that with a prayer. All Council members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Councilman Wright moved to approve the minutes of the December 18, 2017 meeting, and Councilman Asher seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.

Under miscellaneous business, on the organizational meeting for the New Year, Councilman Asher moved to nominate Councilman Nolley as the Council President, and Councilman Wright seconded. Councilman Asher moved to close the nominations, and Councilman Wright seconded. The motion was carried to close the nominations on a 7-0 voice vote. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote to elect Councilman Nolley as President for 2018.

Councilman Ridgeway moved to nominate Councilman Asher as Vice Chair for 2018, and Councilman Phares seconded. Councilman Wright moved to close the nominations, and Councilman Nolley seconded. Councilman Asher was approved as Vice Chair on a 7-0 voice vote.

Councilman Nolley moved to approve Councilman Wright as the Reader for 2018, and Councilwoman Bowen seconded. Councilman Nolley moved to close the nominations, and Councilman Asher seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote to continue having Councilman Wright as the Reader.

Mayor DeBaun read the names of those serving on each of the Council Committees, and Councilman Nolley announced any changes for 2018 on that Committee. Mayor DeBaun then read a list of Liaisons for each of the Departments, and Councilman Nolley mentioned any changes from last year. Councilman Nolley moved to approve the Council Committees and Liaison appointments, and Councilman Phares seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.


On the City's financial reports for November, Councilman Nolley moved to approve them, and Councilman Ridgeway seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.
