

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 23, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 23, 2018, at 8:30 A.M. Mayor DeBaun was absent, and Mr. Finkel presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on January 16, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Police Chief Mark Weidner said Captain Rick Joseph has turned in a letter of retirement, with his retirement day being March 1. Mr. Williams moved to approve the request, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote. The Board wished Captain Joseph well, who served the City for 42 years and 10 months.

Chief Weidner asked permission to hire Josh Kieffer as a new police officer. He is replacing a vacancy from last October that hadn't been filled yet. Mr. Williams moved to hire Mr. Kieffer on a probationary period, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Amy Haacker, executive director of the Blue River Community Foundation, requested permission to host a reception on Thursday, February 22, at 6:00 P.M., at City Hall. It would be a joint event between the Foundation and the City to view and talk about the six sculptured models that are being proposed. The sculpture chosen is to be placed near the Porter Center by the bike-pedestrian trail. Amy said she is applying for a temporary alcohol permit for the reception. She also said the sculptured models will be on display for around six weeks. Mr. Williams moved to approve the request, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel said the next Board of Works meeting will be held on Thursday, February 1, at 8:30 A.M.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
