

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 1, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Thursday, February 1, 2018, at 8:30 A.M. Mr. Williams was absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on January 23, 2018, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Resolution No. 2018-1 was introduced by Mayor DeBaun. He added the Animal Shelter has not increased its adoption fees in at least ten years. This states that the fees should be raised to reflect the costs currently incurred in the provision of the service. In the prelim meeting, Mayor DeBaun said a study was done on neighboring communities, and these rates are not on the high or low end. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the Resolution, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Kim Koehl, executive director of Shelby Senior Services, asked permission to close the west side of the Circle on Friday, June 8, for the annual Strawberry Festival. She asked for it to be closed from midnight until 4:00 P.M. that Friday afternoon. Mayor DeBaun said that will probably coincide with Government Day, where hot dogs, chips, and a drink are given out free to the public. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Finkel moved to adjourn.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-1

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF
SHELBYVILLE, INDIANA, CONCERNING ADOPTION FEES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 90.24 of the City Code of Ordinances, this Board shall set fees for the adoption services provided by the Animal Shelter;

WHEREAS, these fees have not been raised in many years;


WHEREAS, said fees should be raised to reflect the costs currently incurred in the provision of this service; and

WHEREAS, the fees contained in this resolution are reasonably related to the cost of the service provided.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DETERMINED, ESTABLISHED, AND RESOLVED by the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, as follows:

1. The adoption fee for dogs shall be \$95.00.
2. The adoption fee for cats shall be \$50.00. Except that, if a cat was spayed and neutered prior to its impoundment, the adoption fee shall be \$15.00
