

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

January 17, 2018

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, January 17, 2018, at 8:31 A.M. Councilwoman Bowen opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, and Councilman Ridgeway followed that with a prayer. Councilman Phares was absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Councilman Wright moved to approve the minutes of the January 3, 2018 meeting, and Councilman Asher seconded. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

Under miscellaneous business, City Engineer Matt House talked about the progress on the Blue River Trails, saying it will probably take two more years to complete. He said Lisa Herber, from the Department of Natural Resources, was here to present a grant award to the City, and she talked about the recreational trails program, which is an 80/20 matching assistance program. She said the money is used for funding for development and acquisition of land for recreational multi-use trail projects. The amount of the grant award was \$181,518.00.

There was no old business.

Under new business, on Ordinance No. 18-2829, attorney Jason Karmire represented Williams and Williams, LLC, requesting permission to annex .73 acres with a zoning classification of IL-Light Industrial. Councilman Asher moved to approve this on first reading, and Councilman Carmony seconded. Under discussion, Mr. Karmire said there was a strip of ground that wasn't annexed correctly into the City, and he explained how it happened. Councilman Ridgeway thanked Mr. Karmire for the explanation. Mayor DeBaun said there are spots like this around the City that the Planning Department will be bringing to the Council for annexation in the next few weeks. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote on first reading. Mayor DeBaun said this will now be remanded to the Plan Commission for a public hearing.


Under reports from Committees, Boards, and Commissions, Councilman Carmony said there will be a Finance Committee meeting next Monday at 4:00 P.M.
