Regular Meeting

February 13, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 13, 2018, at 8:34 A.M. Mr. Williams was absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.
