

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

March 20, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, March 20, 2018, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present; and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on March 13, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said an improvement order is requested to be sent to the CSX Corporation, notifying them they have thirty days to repair or improve the following railroad crossings: Mausoleum Road, N. Harrison St., John St., Walker St., E. Mechanic St., N. Noble St., E. Franklin St., E. Washington St., and E. Hendricks St. in Shelbyville. Of all the news coverage done in the last six plus years, Mayor DeBaun said this topic is the most positive public feedback they have received. He appreciated the help from the City Attorney, City Engineer, and Street Commissioner to get this moving forward. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Street Commissioner Jennifer Jones said there would be no trash or recycling picked up on Friday, March 30, due to Good Friday. Friday's trash will be picked up along with Monday's trash and recycling, on April 2.

Mayor DeBaun asked the Board's approval of moving the Farmer's Market from the Public Square to the W. Washington St. parking lot location. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
