

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

May 1, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 1, 2018, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on April 24, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun presented two proclamations. The first was to Sue Williams, proclaiming the month of May as Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Month. Sue presented the Mayor with a Freedom of the Road Award from Abate of Indiana, in appreciation of his dedication to motorcycles of Indiana. The second proclamation was presented to Kim Koehl, proclaiming the month as Older Americans Month. Kim is from Shelby Senior Services.

Police Chief Mark Weidner asked the Board to approve SOP number 19. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams noted there won't be a Board meeting next Tuesday, because it's Election Day. The Board will meet next Wednesday, May 9, at 8:30 A.M.

Floyd Hastings came forward saying on May 12 the Eagles Lodge, Eagle Riders 766, will have their ride, and he asked permission to close the first block of E. Franklin St., east of the Fifth Third Bank entrance, to Pike Street. The alleys between E. Mechanic and E. Washington St. will remain open on that first block. The time will be from 7:00 A.M. until 9:00 P.M. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
