

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

May 9, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, May 9, 2018, at 8:31 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on May 1, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.


Under old business, Mr. Finkel moved to award Robertson Paving with the street overlay project, and Mr. Williams seconded. Their low bid amount was \$231, 691.75. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.


Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said Teri Mackey had a request to close certain streets for the St. Joseph Festival being held this week. This had already been requested on February 27, 2018, by Street Commissioner Jennifer Jones, and approved by the Board at that time. Mayor DeBaun said Police Chief Mark Weidner agreed to meet with an unhappy neighbor in the St. Joe area.

Mayor DeBaun wanted to congratulate City Attorney Trent Meltzer on his Primary victory last night over five other Republican candidates for Circuit Court Judge. Trent received a room full of applause.
