

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

May 15, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, at 8:32 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on May 9, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Plan Commission Director Bryant Niehoff said Twin Lakes, LLC requested the Board accept the improvements to Twin Lakes Boulevard, and it's the second phase of that collector street. He said it now connects Amos Rd. and McKay Rd. Bryant said performance bonds have been provided for improvements that have yet to be built, and maintenance bonds have been provided for improvements that have been built and inspected. Bryant said Deputy Commissioner Adam Rude has been working with Twin Lakes on temporary certificates of occupancy for a few of the new apartment buildings out there. Mr. Williams asked if speed limit signs have been put up since Amos and McKay Roads are now connected. Bryant said that would be checked to see that signs have been or will be put up. Mr. Williams moved to approve the improvements, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.


Under new business, Mr. Finkel wanted to make a comment. He said often times we hear of all the problems on the properties that are not maintained, but if you look around town, there are some people that do a fantastic job on their yards, and he really appreciates that.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
