

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

May 22, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 22, 2018, at 8:32 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on May 15, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun said he had the plat for the Twin Lakes commercial subdivision. Plan Commission Director Bryant Niehoff said it will allow the extension of the sanitary sewer main to serve the properties for commercial development along Amos Road. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the plat, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun talked about Resolution No. 2018-2, whereby the City wishes to dispose of certain property to an abutting landowner at the corner of Miller Avenue and Parker Avenue. It is 0.059 acres, it has an assessed value of less than \$15,000.00, and Cork Liquors is wishing to receive the property. Mr. Williams moved to approve the Resolution, and Mr. Finkel seconded. . The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.


