

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

July 10, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, July 10, 2018, at 8:31 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on July 3, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Code Enforcement Officer Troy Merrick came forward to say he has received multiple complaints about trash and debris at 201 E. Franklin Street. The owner is Dick Bishopp, who owns Bishopp's Appliances in Shelbyville and Columbus. Troy provided the Board with pictures from the past few months, showing some progress has been made. Dick talked about issues he had with CGS Services on their trash pickup and charges, so nothing was picked up for two weeks, but they are picking it up now at twice the cost it used to be. If he stays in Shelbyville, he says he's installing cameras at his building to see who is constantly dumping items on his property, causing a bigger mess. When asked, Dick felt he could clean the property in another thirty days. Mr. Finkel moved to allow another thirty days to clean, and then review the property at 201 E. Franklin St., and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun opened and read sealed bids for the Walker St. Blue River Trails Extension. The following companies and their amounts are listed below:

Mr. Williams moved to take the bids under advisement, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote. John Kuntz said the engineer's estimate was \$330,000.00.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
