

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

August 21, 2018

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, August 21, 2018, at 8:29 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on August 14, 2018, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun opened and read sealed bids for the East Washington St. Project. The following companies, along with their various bids, are listed below:

Mr. Finkel moved to take the bids under advisement so they can be reviewed by the City Engineer and others, and Mr. Williams seconded. It is hoped to have an answer in a short while. The motion to take the bids under advisement was approved on a 3-0 voice vote.


Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said Bryant Niehoff, Building and Plan Commission Director, requested permission to approve a revised schedule for HVAC Mechanical permit application fees. Mr. Niehoff said this is a minor modification to what was approved last year. He also said it was in an effort to streamline the process for both contractors and his staff to make the best customer service possible. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mayor DeBaun said Lindy Conover-Thompson requested permission to close the west half of the Public Square at midnight, for the First Friday event on Friday, September 7. Mr. Niehoff spoke on behalf of Lindy, who is the Executive Director of the Arts Alliance. Their group is heading up the First Friday event. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

No one appeared for a dog bite case that was to be heard today. Not knowing anything about the dog, Mr. Williams moved to take this under advisement until next Tuesday, so the animal could be visited at the Animal Shelter. Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion to take this under advisement was approved on a 3-0 voice vote. Mayor DeBaun directed the Animal Shelter staff to notify the owner about today's decision, and that if the owner doesn't appear next week, the animal will be dealt with accordingly.


A recess had been taken so the City Engineer could review the bids for the E. Washington Street Project. Upon reconvening at 8:43 A.M., City Engineer Matt House said the engineer's estimate for the total base bid was \$499,450.00, alternate 1 was \$70,536.00, alternate 2 was \$27,810.00, alternate 3 was \$53,500.00, alternate 4 was \$22,900.00, and no quote was given for alternate 5, which was plant maintenance. Since the bids were quite a bit higher than anticipated, Mr. Williams moved to continue taking the bids under advisement, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote to take the bids under advisement.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
