

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 29, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 29, 2019, at 8:36 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on January 22, 2019, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Senior Services Executive Director, Kim Koehl, requested permission to close the west half of the Circle on Friday, June 14, so they can have their annual Strawberry Festival. Mayor DeBaun also noted that the east half of the Circle would be used for its annual Municipal Government Day event. Mr. Williams moved to close the entire Circle for those events on June 14, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Because of the extreme cold expected tomorrow, Mayor DeBaun said there would be no trash or recycling picked up on Wednesday, January 30, 2019. The Mayor said employees at the Garage will have to take a personal or vacation day off tomorrow, or if they come in, they will have to volunteer their day helping at the Senior Services Center. Wednesday's trash will be picked up on Thursday, and Wednesday's recycling will be picked up on its regular day next week.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
