

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 12, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 12, 2019, at 8:28 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on February 5, 2019, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0-1 voice vote, with Mr. Williams abstaining.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun said there were two proposals for Blue River Memorial Park's infrastructure improvements. After review by a scoring committee, Parks Director Karen Martin recommended the proposal by Bowen Engineering Corporation. Mr. Williams moved to approve the request, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun opened and read sealed bids on the W. Franklin St. project. The following companies, along with their bids for asphalt and/or concrete are listed below:

City Engineer Matt House said the engineer's estimate was \$183,445.00. Mr. Finkel moved to take all bids on the W. Franklin St. project under advisement, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried to take the bids under advisement on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mayor DeBaun opened and read sealed bids on the 2019 Street Overlay project. The following companies, along with their bid amounts are listed below:
