

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 19, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 19, 2019, at 8:38 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on February 12, 2019, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun asked City Engineer Matt House to come forward to talk about the bids opened last week for the 2019 Street Overlay project. Robertson Paving's bid of \$621,198.50 was recommended. Mr. Williams moved to approve the recommendation, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

On the W. Franklin St. project, Midwest Paving's bid of \$163,748.30 was recommended for approval, with asphalt. Mr. Williams moved to approve the request, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun opened and read sealed bids on the E. Washington St. Redevelopment project. The following companies, along with their bids are listed below:
