

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

June 4, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, June 4, 2019, at 8:31 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

If the Community Corrections office moves, then the signage would be removed. Mr. Williams moved to approve the request, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
