

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

June 18, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, June 18, 2019, at 8:31 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on June 11, 2019, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said a couple representatives of Wal-Mart had a request to do their annual roadblock at Mechanic and Harrison St. on two Saturdays, June 22 and June 29, from 10:00 A.M. until 2:00 P.M. When they also asked if they could do roadblocks on the third Saturday of every month through September, Mr. Finkel felt it would desensitize drivers to giving because other charities have roadblocks as well. The couple then asked if they could also do a roadblock at the intersection of McKay and St. Rd. 9 on June 22 and 29. Mr. Finkel moved to approve having roadblocks at both locations, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote. Mayor DeBaun asked them to come back in the fall when they want to do another roadblock.


Fire Chief Tony Logan came forward requesting permission to revise SOG 602, which requires emergency transfers from Major Hospital to hospitals in other counties, which could diminish the staff and equipment locally. Chief Logan said 27 emergency transfers were done last year. Mr. Williams moved to approve the SOG 602 revision, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

City Engineer Matt House came forward to request permission to amend additional contract services with Butler, Fairman and Seufert, Inc. and Ratio on the E. Washington St. Redevelopment Construction Phase Services. The total is not to exceed \$31,000.00. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

On behalf of Indiana Grand Racing & Casino, Police Lt. Mike Turner came forward requesting permission to obtain a temporary traffic restriction on Co. Rd. 200W, between Michigan Rd. and Co. Rd. 450N between the hours of 10:00 P.M.-11:30 P.M. This will be for their annual fireworks display to be held Wednesday evening, July 3 around 10:30 P.M. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.


Denise Holland, with Major Health Partners (MHP), requested permission to have two items approved. The first was for their annual Get Healthy Here Farmers Market, and the mobile market that MHP is sponsoring again this year. On the first item, Denise asked permission to use the grassy area in the old hospital lot, just for yoga. It would be a part of the physical activity going on that morning, and it was felt it would do better if it was away from the noise and traffic. Denise also asked if people could park their cars in front of the parking lot on W. Washington St., from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 A.M., so they can unload and then they would park elsewhere. She said the date would be Saturday, July 13. On the mobile market, if there is bad weather, it's hoped to have indoor locations available for people at three locations in the City. They are at First Presbyterian Church, Builders Lumber, and the Parks Department. They will be held every other week, and then once a month, they will go to Charles Major Manor, and Blue Ridge Terrace. Because of another commitment, Denise asked if the mobile market could be held across the street from the First Presbyterian Church, on Thursday, July 11. They will be from 4:00 P.M. until 5:30 P.M. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the requests, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
