

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

August 19, 2019

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, August 19, 2019, at 8:30 A.M. Councilwoman Bowen opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, and Councilman Ridgeway followed that with a prayer. Councilmen Nolley and Phares were absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Councilman Wright moved to approve the minutes of the August 5, 2019 meeting, and Councilman Asher seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, on Resolution No. 2019-25, concerning a Riverfront License for J. Scott Fuchs at Cadillac Jack's, Councilwoman Bowen moved to approve and amend Section 6 (a) of the formal written commitment by changing the establishment from smoking to non-smoking. Councilman Wright seconded. Under discussion, questions about the license were talked about and it wasn't known how long Scott might have to wait before hearing back from the state. The motion to approve the Resolution was carried on a 4-1 voice vote, with Councilman Ridgeway voting no.

Personnel Director Jody Branum came forward requesting permission to approve job reclassifications for three City Employees. They were for the Fire Department, Street Department, and the Animal Shelter, and with their additional duties, it was felt they should be moved from a COMOT III to a COMOT II level. Jody said monies have been put into their salaries for 2020. Councilwoman Bowen asked Jody if she could look into the job descriptions of others because of increased duties and social media, and Jody said she could. Councilman Asher said the three employees have done a good job, so he moved to approve the job reclassifications, and Councilman Wright seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

On Ordinance No. 19-2865, to rezone the Tindall property north of Greenleaf Foods from a BH classification to an IG classification, Councilman Asher moved to approve on first reading, and Councilman Wright seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

On Resolution No. 2019-23, transferring \$750,000.00 in Racino funds to the Rainy Day Fund, Councilwoman Bowen moved to approve, and Councilman Willis seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

On Ordinance No. 19-2866, it allows the City Council to authorize certain types of disbursements to be made before the Board of Works has its weekly meeting. Councilwoman Bowen moved to approve this on first reading, and Councilman Asher seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Councilman Wright moved to adjourn.
