

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting September 17, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, September 17, 2019, at 8:28 A.M. Mr. Finkel was absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on September 10, 2019, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun said people were present to talk about the property located at 111 E. Hendricks St. Jeff Wallenius came forward to say they had a buyer for the property, so she came forward to say her name was Ann Doty. Ann said the plan was to get at least two quotes to demolish the house as soon as possible. In order to speed up the process, Mayor DeBaun asked Ann if the City could demolish the home and have her be assessed the charges, and she said yes. Mr. Williams moved to amend the date from September 26 to October 1 to demolish the home and assess the costs, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun opened and read sealed bids for the Indiana Avenue and Ohio Street storm water improvements. The following companies, along with their bid amounts are listed below:

Olco	\$169,596.12


Although not mentioned in the meeting, the engineer's estimate was \$156,576.00. Mr. Williams moved to take the bids under advisement, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion to take the bids under advisement was approved on a 2-0 voice vote.

Plan Commission Director Adam Rude said a letter was sent on September 4, to clean junk and debris within ten days, at 910 Elm Street. Since that didn't happen, he asked to have an order to appear issued. Mr. Williams moved to have an order to appear issued, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
