

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

November 19, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, November 19, 2019, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on November 12, 2019, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0-1 voice vote, with Mr. Finkel abstaining.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Plan Commission Director Adam Rude said the property at 316 W. Taylor St. has not been cleaned up after a letter was sent in September, and it looks even worse now. Mr. Rude asked for an order to appear be sent to the tenant and the property owner. Mr. Finkel moved to approve sending orders to appear, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under other business, Mr. Finkel wanted to comment on thanking the City staff for taking care of the issues on W. Franklin St., saying it will end up being a positive, thanks to their hard work.

Mayor DeBaun reminded everyone about the Christmas Parade coming up later this week on Friday.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
