Regular Meeting

November 26, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, November 26, 2019, at 8:31 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.
