

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 07, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 07, 2020, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on December 31, 2019, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Tom Davis with Genesis Property Development presented updates on the Parking Garage Project. Demolition work of the former Bradley Hall building will begin January 20, 2020. Franklin Street, Union Street, and Washington Street sidewalks surrounding the building will be closed. The project is speculated to be finished late October. Mr. Williams moved to approve the Parking Garage Project, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Tom Davis with Genesis Property Development also presented updates on the Hamilton Major Housing Project. The plan includes closing the alley that runs from Washington Street to Franklin Street, as well as closing the alley that runs from Franklin Street to Mechanic Street. Work will begin January 20, 2020 and conclude late June. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the Hamilton Major Housing Project, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

The board is keeping communication with the two projects a priority. First Christian Church and Mr. Chris King were both recognized for allowing the city access to their properties during these projects.


Mainstreet Shelbyville Executive Director Brandy Coomes also stated for the record that Mainstreet will play a part in educating and helping businesses continue to thrive during construction times by providing meetings and a web site.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
