

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 21, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 21, 2020, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meetings held on January 14, 2020 Regular Meeting and January 16, 2020 Special Meeting, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0-1 voice vote noting a minor change to be added to the January 14, 2020 minutes. Mr. Finkel abstained from vote.


There was no old business.

Under new business, Police Chief Weidner recommended that Patrolman Frederick McConnaughey be permanently appointed to the Shelbyville Police Department effective January 7, 2020. He has completed a one year probationary period and has completed all training necessary. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the recommendation, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.


