

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

January 22, 2020

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, January 22, 2020, at 8:30 A.M. Councilwoman Bowen opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, and Councilman Furgeson followed that with a prayer. Councilman Willis and Councilman Conrady were absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Councilman Nolley moved to approve the minutes of the January 6, 2020 meeting, and Councilman Johnson seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

Under miscellaneous business, Councilman Nolley moved to appoint Councilman Willis as an alternate for the Plan Commission, Councilman Furgeson seconded. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Councilman Nolley moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance 20-2872, Councilwoman Bowen seconded. The ordinance is an amendment to the existing salary ordinance. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

In new business, Councilwoman Bowen moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance 20-2874, Councilman Nolley seconded. The ordinance is an amendment to the existing substance abuse policy. Random testing has been raised to fifty percent of all CDL employees. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Councilman Asher moved to approve Resolution 2020-4, Councilwoman Bowen seconded. Resolution 2020-4 replaced Resolution 2019-29 which is a personal and real property tax deduction in an economic revitalization area. Brazeway Indiana Inc. was represented by General Manager John Armstrong and Attorney Stephen Schrumppf. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

In other business, David Lawson made a presentation that proposed new housing behind existing additions Clearview and Countryside. Mr. Lawson stated that these would be considered two separate projects. Mr. Lawson wanted the city to help bridge the gap by investing in infrastructure needs. After hearing his presentation, Councilman Furgeson moved that the Council will continue to move forward in faith and confidence of the project, Councilman Johnson seconded. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.


