

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 11, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 11, 2020, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the financial claims as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes from the February 4, 2020 meeting as presented, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Chief Logan, after reviewing the 3 bids from the February 4, 2020 meeting, recommended the bid from Warner Truck Body. He considered this bid to be sufficient and also least expensive. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the recommendation, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Chief Logan requested permission to offer conditional employment to Travis Slinkard. Mr. Williams moved to continue the hiring process, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Also under new business, Indiana American Water requested to shutdown West St. between Franklin St. and Mechanic St. This is part of the Hamilton Major Project. Mr. Williams moved to approve, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote. Indiana American Water also issued precautionary boiling water notice for the specific area.

After the regular business of the Board of Works was concluded, the Board began the hearing on the disciplinary matter of Lt. Clifford Coffman of the Shelbyville Police Department. Lt. Coffman was represented by M. Elizabeth Bemis. The Shelbyville Police Department was represented by Jennifer L. Meltzer. The Board of Works was assisted by attorney Amanda Blacketter. Testimony proceeded into the afternoon. The board concluded by taking the matter under advisement awaiting Finding of Fact from the attorneys representing each side. The Findings of Fact are due 10 days from this date.
