

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

February 17, 2020

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, February 17, 2020, at 8:30AM. Councilwoman Bowen opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, and Councilman Conrady followed that with the prayer. Councilman Furgeson and Councilman Johnson were absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Councilman Asher moved to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2020 meeting, and Councilman Conrady seconded. The motion was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Councilman Conrady moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance 20-2873, Councilman Nolley seconded. The ordinance is to annex to the City of Shelbyville certain real estate and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith to the extent of such conflict only (Trinity Metals). Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.

In new business, Councilman Asher moved to approve Ordinance No. 20-2875, Councilman Nolley seconded. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote. This ordinance was to re-establish a Cum Cap Development Fund under I.C. 36-9-15.5.

Also in new business, Councilman Nolley moved to approve Resolution 2020-6, seconded by Councilman Conrady. This resolution explained the fiscal plan for the Trinity Metals annexation. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote.


Also in new business, Councilman Nolley moved to approve Resolution 2020-7, seconded by Councilman Asher. Vote was carried on a 5-0 voice vote. This resolution was to approve the development agreement for Clearview. David Lawson was on hand for questions.

In other business, Andrew Lyon presented to Council regarding the potential location of headquarters of the National Contemporary Orchestra in Shelbyville. After presentation, Council asked for more information about total budget. Councilman Asher made comment that Tourism may be a perfect fit as another partner. After receiving additional information, Council will put together a possible proposal.


There were no reports from department heads or committees

There were no comments or requests from citizens.

There being no further business, Councilman Asher moved to adjourn.
