

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 18, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 18, 2020, at 8:30 A.M. Mayor DeBaun was absent, and Mr. Williams presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the financial claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Matt House, City Engineer presented a new version of the construction standards. This was an update of the 2014 standards. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the new standards, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.


Also under old business, Chief Logan updated the board on a possible change in truck body bids. Warner Truck Bodies had discontinued this particular division. Chief Logan was going to investigate a second option in Iowa. He will return to the board with a new recommendation following further investigation and scrutiny.

Under new business, Adam Rude, Planning Director, informed the board that properties at 102 McKinley St. and 558 E. Broadway are now in compliance. The 629 E. Jackson St. property still requires another round of services and proper notification.

Also under new business, Jenny Meltzer, City Attorney, introduced a Duke Energy contract to the board. This is a contract for new city lighting giving options of upfront payment or making monthly payments for a number of years. She will return to the board next week for direction and approval.

Under additional business, Kim Koehl, Executive Director of Senior Services, requested that the west side of the circle be closed June 12, 2020 for the Strawberry Festival. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Being no other business, Mr. Finkel moved to adjourn meeting.
