

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

February 3, 2020

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, February 3, 2020, at 7:00 P.M. Councilman Willis opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, and Councilman Comrady followed that with the prayer. Councilman Furgeson was absent, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Councilman Nolley moved to approve the minutes of the January 22, 2020 meeting, and Councilman Asher seconded. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Councilman Nolley moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance 20-2874, Councilman Comrady seconded. The ordinance is an amendment the substance abuse policy. Vote was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

Also under old business, Steve Schrumpf represented public hearings for Resolution 2020-2 and Resolution 2020-3. These resolutions focus on designating an economic revitalization area. Councilwoman Bowen moved to approve, Councilman Johnson seconded. Vote was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

In new business, Councilman Willis moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance 20-2873, Councilman Comrady seconded. The ordinance is to annex to the city of Shelbyville certain real estate and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith to the extent of such conflict only. Vote was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Councilman Asher moved to approve Resolution 2020-5, Councilman Nolley seconded. This resolution was for the adoption and approval of the energy saving equipment lease. Vote was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.


